

Ann Howard Choral Scholarship

Purpose:

The Church of the Covenant seeks to support a uniquely talented high school student in his/her pursuits of a career in music through a nine-month choral internship with Covenant's professional choir. This opportunity can provide quality training in singing, music-reading, professional responsibility, and civic duty, as well as exposure to a wide-array of choral literature.

The scholarship is named after Ann Howard, who faithfully served in the Covenant Choir for nearly 60 years. Her faithfulness and commitment to great music serves as a great example toward which every chorister should strive.

Terms:

The internship is open to all high school applicants (grades 9-12) regardless of race, ethnicity, sex, religion, or voice-type.

Applicants must be actively enrolled in a high school and maintain high grades.

The internship shall last for one complete choral season (September to June) including all rehearsals and performances (typically one rehearsal and service per week, including occasional concerts and extra rehearsals).

Remuneration shall be \$200 per month not to exceed nine months.

The intern must adhere to a binding contractual agreement.

Application Procedure:

Fill out a complete application and mail to the indicated address.

Applicants must fulfill an audition with the director of music.

The audition process will include:

Two songs from the classical or sacred-classical repertoire.

One song must be in a language other than English.

A short sight-reading excerpt.

An accompanist will be provided.

Applicants will be judged on their vocal ability and musicianship.

First place and runner-up awards may be granted.

The runner-up will be eligible to fulfill the position in the event that the first place winner is not able to complete the internship.

The Church reserves the right not to award the scholarship if the applicant(s) do not meet the standards required for the position.
